

ClipRecorder Keyboard Commands

The table below outlines the keyboard commands available in Drastic QuickClip Pro. Please note, if the application focus is on a text entry box, many of these commands will be interpreted as standard key presses and not have the desired effect.

Play x 2	<shift>-C
Pause	v or k or <keypad .>
Reverse Play	b or j or <keypad 0>
Fast Rewind	z
Fast Forward	x

Shuttle Forward	' or <keypad 3>
Step Forward] or <keypad 2>

Forward 5 Seconds	} (<shift>-])

Preview In to Out	w or <keypad 8>
Record	q

Goto Out	<shift>-N or <end> or <shift + keypad 5>

* – These only work in some cases, depending which control on the interface has focus. Not recommended for general use, use the keyboard equivalents above.
